Jon McClure is the General Manager of Osage Valley Electric Cooperative. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Truman State University (North East Missouri State) in 1974. Prior to his position in Butler he was General Manager of Grundy Electric Cooperative in Trenton Mo. He serves as a Board Member of KAMO (Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma Power Cooperative). He also serves on various local boards and civic clubs.

His topic will be a review of the current power generation for Missouri Cooperatives and looking to the future for the next generation of supply.
